- The second team member is strictly prohibited from reading what the first team member has written.
- After the first team member completes their writing, there will be a strict time limit of 30 seconds for discussion between the two team members.
- After the discussion, the second team member will continue the piece.
- Participants should be mindful of the time limits for both writing and discussion.
- Any projection of profanity or plagiarism is strictly prohibited and will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Entries will be judged based on creativity, coherence, the adherence to the prompt and writing style. Both poetic and prose contributions will be evaluated, and the focus is on how well the two pieces come together as a unified work.
