Further he shared that in addition to these schools and departments, the following centres have also been constituted in the University:

He also notified the members that the University has started new programmes on BPT, MPT and Ph.D. under the College of Physiotherapy and Allied Health Sciences, a constituent unit of the University.

In addition, with the commitment to improving education outcomes, the University has implemented NEP-2020. The programme structures and curricula has been redesigned as per NEP-2020 and have been approved in the respective Boards of Studies, to be implemented from session 2023-24. Moreover, the Ph.D. byelaws have also been reframed according to the UGC Regulations (for the award of M.Phil/Ph.D. degree), 2022 and NEP-2020 guidelines.

He also informed the members that University has been approved as a Training Provider cum Training Centre under (PMKVY) Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna 4.0. PMKVY is the flagship scheme of the Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship (MSDE) implemented by National Skill Development Corporation. The objective of this Skill Certification Scheme is to enable a large number of Indian youth to take up industry-relevant skill training that will help them in securing a better livelihood. Under this program, students will be trained by professionals. Certificates will also be provided by the respective skill councils approved under the scheme.

Following courses shall be offered by the University under PMKVY 4.0

- 1. Assistant hair dresser and Stylist
- 2. Craft Baker
- 3. Office Assistant
- 4. Hand block printer
- 5. Yoga trainer

He also shared that the Journal of Arts published by the University is now both in print and online ISSN, editions.

ITEM III TO DISCUSS THE SUGGESTIONS SUBMITTED BY AQAR CRITERION COORDINATORS FOR IMPROVEMENT

IQAC coordinator informed the members that taking into consideration, the new AQAR and SSR formats, NAAC Benchmarks, and SOP, suggestions were invited from AQAR Criterion Coordinators regarding improvement in University processes & practices and IQAC data collection procedures (Annexure- II).

All criterion coordinators were invited one by one to share their suggestions with the members. The members approved the same along with the following suggestions:

- An exhaustive list of National & International Level awards from Government /Government recognized bodies may be prepared for perusal of faculty members.
- In addition to research awards and innovation awards, faculty members can also apply for awards for social service from government aided NGOs.
- The faculty members can become life members of national and international societies.
- Key Performance Indicators (KPI) should be drafted information of for faculty members for improvement specifically in Criterion III (Research, Innovations and Extension).
- Counselling by the Career Counselling and Development Cell should be organized in structured manner.
- Construction of solar parking vehicle shades can be helpful in more energy generation, positively impacting university economy.
- Invite philanthropists to discuss how they can contribute towards the growth of the University.

Suggestions from the members were noted, and the chairperson assured the members to work on the valuable suggestion given by them.

ITEM IV TO SHARE THE REPORTS OF FEEDBACK MONITORING COMMITTEE FOR SESSION 2021-22

Dr. Ruchi Nanda, Nodal officer, Feedback Monitoring Committee briefed the members about working of the committee and shared the feedback and action taken reports for session 2021-22 (Annexure-III). The following suggestions were made by the members:

- Sh. Mahendra Surana suggested to include options like 'good', 'very good', 'excellent', 'extra ordinary' etc. . The 'satisfactory' option does not convey quality of education provided by IISU.
- Prof. N.D. Mathur suggested that the sample size should be mentioned in all the feedback reports.

Suggestions from the members were noted.

ITEM V TO PLAN ACADEMIC AUDIT OF DEPARTMENTS FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-24

Dr. Kalpana Agarwal, Coordinator, Academic audit, briefed the members about proposal of conducting the academic audits of different departments in the academic session 2023-24. She informed the members that audits are proposed to be conducted in two phases, I and II:

In Phase I, six departments, 3 with strong and 3 with weak research indices will be selected from different schools. The audits will be conducted by teams consisting of external and internal members. The proposed schedule for audit of phase I is November-December, 2023.

Phase II audit will be conducted by internal faculty members only i.e. by those selected for phase I and audit of all the remaining departments and centres is proposed to be conducted in the academic session 2023-24. The proposed schedule for Phase II audit is in April-May, 2024.

Members provided their unanimous approval for the same.

ITEM VI TO DISCUSS ABOUT SOFTWARE DESIGNING FOR SELF-APPRAISAL OF FACULTY MEMBERS

Coordinator, IQAC shared with the members that in order to streamline the documentation process, improve quality, consistency and data collection, IQAC is planning to automate the self-appraisal system. A pilot interface has been prepared by Dr. Amita Sharma and Dr. Ruchi Nanda of Dept. of CS & IT with the help of their students, which is ready for presentation and implementation after being tested.

Dr. Amita Sharma briefed the members about the features of the software. Members appreciated the efforts of IQAC and faculty and students involved in development of the software.

ITEM VII TO SHARE THE DIFFERENT UNIVERSITY POLICIES / DOCUMENTS PREPARED UNDER NEP

Dr. Payal Chaturvedi, IQAC Coordinator, shared with the members that after detailed discussions, different policies / documents have been prepared by the sub-committees of NEP Cell of the University. The coordinators of the sub-committees gave short presentations on the following policies:

Coordinator, IQAC shared with members that the Department of Biotechnology of the University has been sanctioned the Postgraduate Teaching Program (M.Sc.) in Biotechnology by DBT. The department will commence the programme from session 2023-24 (Annexure-IV).

ITEM IX TO CONSIDER AND APPROVE THE IQAC CALENDAR OF ACADEMIC SESSION 2023-24

The tentative IQAC calendar for the academic session 2023-24 was approved by the members. (Annexure-V)

SUGGESTIONS FROM AQAR CRITERION COORDINATORS

CRITERION I: Curricular Aspects

To further enhance the curricular aspects of our university, we propose the following suggestions:

1. Mapping Syllabi with Online Courses:

Encourage departments to map their existing syllabi with courses available on different online platforms such as MOOCs, SWAYAM, and NPTEL. This mapping process will help identify opportunities to replace or supplement existing units or entire courses with online offerings. By incorporating high-quality online courses into our curriculum, we can provide students with access to a wider range of resources and perspectives.

2. Mandating Short-term Course Certificates:

Make it mandatory for students to earn a certificate by completing at least one short-term course from online platforms. Faculty members can incorporate this requirement into their courses by assigning activities or assignments that involve completing an online course and submitting the certificate as proof. This approach not only promotes lifelong learning but also exposes students to emerging topics and skills beyond the traditional classroom.

3. Implementing Mandatory Internships:

Introduce mandatory internships for both undergraduate and postgraduate programs. Internships provide students with handson industry exposure, which is crucial in the current job market. If any program currently lacks this component, it is necessary to redesign or restructure the syllabi. Alternatively, departments can consider introducing research-based projects or lab/field-based activities, assigning a faculty member as a guide or mentor to ensure proper implementation and evaluation. To increase research output, we propose assigning different titles for each research project and introducing research projects in the second year and internships in the third year.

CRITERION II : Teaching-Learning and Evaluation

2.2.1

Assessment of Learning Levels of students & special programs organized for slow & advanced learners

A number of programs such as FDPs, Academic Lectures, Webinars, Workshops, Online courses are arranged. Tutoring slow learners also help the slow as well as advanced learners

Slow learners are helped through remedial teaching, use of models, peer tutoring by high ability classmates, encouraging them to spend more time on reading in libraries, learning opportunities though online sources like YouTube.

Faculty members are motivated to take part in National & International Level competitions organized by Government /Government recognized bodies

CRITERION III : Research, Innovations and Extension

- 1. We may formulate the strategies to increase number of paper publications in UGC-care/ Indexed journals.
- Faculty members may be motivated to create good E-content for various MOOC platforms.
- 3. Consultancy Policy can be updated for encouraging revenue generation from consultancy and corporate trainings.
- 4. Initiatives may be taken to improve the number of MOUs.
- 5. Efforts can be made to attract faculty members for getting seed money for research from the University.
- Faculty members may be encouraged to apply for more financial support from various government and non government funding agencies.

CRITERION IV: Infrastructure and Learning Resources

As the focus of metric is on acquiring new infrastructure, acquisition of new infrastructure will help gain more points but due to some ifrastructure constraints we can improve upon learning resources. we can increase Recurring expenditure on laboratory, maintenance of infrastructure and acquisition of books and journals are not counted under this metric. Amount spent on purchase of books, e-resources and Journals can be increased. As per SOP the computers for office and faculty use will not be considered, thus it is suggested to purchase more computers for resource enhancement and their usage.

CRITERION V: Student Support and Progression

- More strategies and policies to strengthen the no. of students benefited by scholarships & freeships provided by the institution, Government and non-government bodies, industries, individuals, philanthropists may be there.
- More of career counselling activities can be conducted.
- MOU's should be signed with coaching institutes providing guidance for competitive exams.
- Active student coordinators can encourage the students to appear for placement drives.
- Alumnae who are placed or are entrepreneurs can be tapped by the departments so that they can bring placements to the campus.
- Students may be counselled, briefed and motivated regarding various competitive exams they could appear for.

CRITERION VI : Governance, Leadership and Management

- Efforts to receive Funds / Grants from non-government bodies, individuals, philanthropists during the year for development and maintenance of infrastructure.
- Financial support may be provided to teaching staff to attend conferences /workshops and towards membership fee of professional bodies during the year.
- More professional development / administrative training Programmes for teaching and non-teaching staff may be organized during the year.

CRITERION VII : Institutional Values and Best Practices

Various measures for water and energy conservation resources may be adopted. Robust mechanism for solid and liquid waste management may be functional. Audits may be conducted once or twice and two to three best practices may be identified during the assessment period.

This is with reference to your M.Sc. Biotechnology proposal submitted to Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science & Technology, Gol, for financial support under DBT PG Teaching Programme. I am happy to inform you that the DBT-Steering Committee on HRD and Skill Vigyan has considered your proposal and recommended for financial support during 15th Finance Commission (2022-23 to 2024-25). The Recommendations of DBT-Steering Committee are as follows your kind perusal and necessary action:

"The Committee recommended the proposal for financial support subject to adoption of DBT's Mandatory Terms & Conditions for DBT PG Programme."

If you are ready to join the DBT PG Teaching Programme as per DBT Mandatory Terms and Conditions, kindly submit the signed copy through email within 10 days (i.e., on or before 25th March 2023), otherwise it will be presumed that your institute is no longer interested in DBT support for proposed PG Teaching Program. You are requested to submit the original hard copy of the same in due course of time. It may however, be noted that no change in any clause of the mandatory terms and conditions will be accepted, if same has been found at any point of time, the support will be withdrawn without any notice.

An early response, latest by 25th March, 2023 should reach us for further action at our end.
